Specification BROKER'S COMMENTS

KIS is a Spirit of Tradition day sailer designed for the relatively light wind conditions of the Mediterranean and inspired by the Skerry cruisers of Scandinavia and yachts such as the all-conquering BONA FIDE that have proved so successful on the classic racing circuit. She is in our view a modern interpretation of the fin and bulb rater – fast and exciting to sail, so she is a provocative mix. Designed also for easy transport and storage, KIS is not pretending to be a vintage yacht. She is however a unique and thrilling design – if you dare to be different !



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Specification DESIGN COMMENTARY

This design has been inspired by many yachts and in particular the Scandinavian Skerry cruisers, all Metre class designs, hull shapes of America's Cup yachts post Millenium, Herreshoff and Fife designs, along with some Dutch lake sailing yachts. The lines therefore derive somehow from detailed study of all these yachts.

Notwithstanding modern design concepts, the lines have however been drawn in the traditional way by hand and then faired with the aid of CAD design software. KIS has an IRC rating certificate and has been developed intentionally for the Spirit of Tradition races in the Mediterranean, the Caribbean and North America.
